Mamma Mia! Ticket prices to Las Vegas Performances are soaring.

As of March 21, the average seat at a Vegas show costs \$69.45, up 12% from 62.02 the same week in 2006, the LasVegasAdvisor.com newsletter reports. Nineteen of 75 shows surveyed have at least one ticket category of \$100 or more, up from 12 last year.

Highest-priced ticket? A top seat at Barry Manilow's show (\$253.50, including tax).

Lowest: \$19.95 for *The Comedy Stop* (which gets you a drink, too).
