2006 – A Year that Manilow Won't Forget

2006 was an amazing ride for both Barry and his fan base alike. A #1 and #2 Album in the Billboard Hot 200. Let's not forget the "Manilow: Music and Passion – Live from the Las Vegas Hilton" show to benefit PBS television, which aired in March. Also, "First and Farewell DVD!" which shot to Number 1! Does anyone remember who went on to win the Emmy for Best Individual Performance in a Musical or Variety Program? How about appearing on the American Music Awards? Or making an appearance in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade? And being nominated for a Grammy (as producer) along with Bette Midler for the Peggy Lee Album. And there was a little trip overseas to perform for Prince Charles and the Duchess of Cornwall for the Royal Variety Performance, and to host an album signing. And he helped launch a Cruise Ship for Holland America with the Today Show. He held a listening party for 300 of his closest friends in New York for the 50's Album. He held "An Evening of Music and Passion" in both Atlantic City and Chicago. He continued to pack the house in Las Vegas for "Music and Passion." This caused the "M" Store to have to expand. Not to mention appearing on every major television talk show at least once (sometimes twice!). He had fantastic success with sales of the 60's album on QVC, selling the most albums in one week in their on-air selling history. "Mandy" the muzak version is featured in the movie "A Night at the Museum." He also found time to help some favorite charities raise money, by performing at the Aids Assistance Program, and at the Carousel Ball of Hope, not to mention helping his friend Suzanne Somers put together her act for Vegas, as well as to help raise money for causes she believes in. And in between all of this he found out he needed to have surgery on his hips; that surgery would side line him for approximately 6 weeks. Not to mention a bunch of Re-Mastered Re-Released Classics, which include the 1977 "LIVE" album!

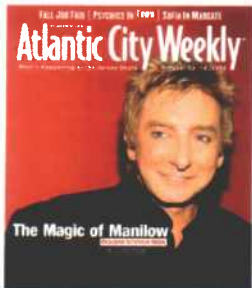

It starts when the curtain comes down on the main stage, and Barry shuffles off, not to Buffalo, but to a side stage decorated with beads, a lava lamp, and shag rug, a small table, and a chair. I'll call it the Lava Lounge. Barry puts on a pink/purple nehru jacket and immediately, I think, "I've got to hit the thrift shops tomorrow and find one of those." He then slides into some gentle banter about the 1960s being a decade of flower children and all that, before noticing something on the table. "It's a cigarette," he says. "Oh," he clarifies, "it's one of *those* cigarettes." He then places it to his lips and, ostensibly, takes up. And I don't mean he's leaving something for the dealers.

You read that right. As part of a Las Vegas stage show, **Barry Manilow simulated lighting up a spliff**. And he *did* inhale, because in the middle of his next sentence, he just trailed off and sat there, wordless, with a smile on his face, for about 10 seconds.
